

The Price is... Eternal Vigilance

Seems like most of the times I go fishing I hear someone say, "You should been here yesterday. I caught my limit in less than an hour." In fact, the last time I was fishing, a fellow fisherman said, "Two days ago I caught over 20 bass in this area. I don't know what's wrong with 'em today."

I realize that some part of the explanation for this is "fishermen." "All fishermen are liars but me and thee... and sometimes I have my doubts about thee!" But it is true that "You can't catch 'em if you're not out there."

"A big part of success is showing up every morning." If you don't show up you're not going to get paid. If you don't show up you can't win. Showing up regularly is a key to every accomplishment. Wendell Phillips (19th century civil rights leader) said, "Vigilance is the eternal price of liberty."

As I think about it, I think vigilance is the price of accomplishing and maintaining every good thing in life. Vigilance means you must be awake... alert... responsive. It means that your guard is always up.

There are some things in life that are worth your "eternal vigilance." Your family is one. The welfare of the Lord's church is another. I think most of us at Woodland Oaks have some realization of how much the Lord has blessed us. I don't mean physically... even though obviously he has done that. I mean spiritually. I mean the fact that we have a family atmosphere. We have a spirit of cooperation and love in this family. We are not plagued with undercurrents of divisiveness. We are not victims of power struggles. We have a leadership that is open and genuinely cares about God's flock. We are blessed with a servant-attitude... in folks of every age. We have a family that has a love for God's word.

Vigilance is the price of maintaining this atmosphere. When we take it for granted and are not alert to dangers, we will lose it. When we achieve a goal, we tend to become more vulnerable.

We are nearing the end of a goal toward which we have been working since this congregation first began - the completion of a building which will maximize the capacity of our property. Let's remember, this is not our real goal. This is a means; not an end. Our goal is to bring one more soul to a saving relationship with our Lord.

Stay vigilant.


