"Why Are You Picking On Them?"

Have you noticed how many folks are offended by God's law? Recently, when Phil Robertson (Duck Dynasty fame) very nearly quoted 1 Corinthians 6: 9-10 (a passage which includes homosexuals in a list of persons who "will not inherit the kingdom of God"), a large number of people were infuriated. Since that time, the vast majority of media writers have labeled his comments as "ignorant," "hateful," "homophobic" and numerous other derogatory labels.

A common response to using scripture to teach that God disapproves of homosexuality is – "Why are you picking on homosexuals? The bible also condemns other so-called sins. Why are you focusing on homosexuality?"

I have an answer for that. If you look at the list of sins in that passage, as far as I can tell, there is no overt, concerted effort on the part of a significant portion of our population to legalize, legitimize and provide special rights to persons who are involved in any of the other sins listed in that passage! If such an effort were underway to force acceptance of thieves, drunkards, swindlers or idolaters, I would be equally as vocal in teaching God's opposition to that practice. Because such a large number of the media, our government leaders, school officials and even religious institutions have made it plain that one of their primary goals is to bring about the acceptance of homosexuality – that's why Christians have become so vocal on this topic. "You (above) have brought the focus on it. You brought it to the "public square." Now you are trying to silence all opposing voices and only allow your beliefs to be heard."

For the record, I'm not saying anything about homosexual sins that is not true of all sins (including my own). "The wages of sin is death." The only door of hope for all of us is repentance.
