

Walking Through the Graveyard

Have you ever walked through a graveyard at night? How did you walk?

I can remember doing that very thing as a kid. And if you're by yourself, it's particularly daunting. First of all, you're probably not going to take that route at night unless it is absolutely necessary- especially if you're not with someone you're trying to impress. But if it seems to be particularly advantageous for some reason, you begin boldly. With determined, deliberate steps. Soon you hear noises. Not regular kind of noises. Something... moving.

So you decide to whistle. Somehow whistling shows you're brave. You don't care. You're not concerned. But soon you realize that something is following you. So you whistle louder (maybe it's not convinced about just how unconcerned you are). A quick check over your shoulder. Both of 'em.

Then you do something you've never done before in your entire life- you start turning in a circle as you walk! So nothing can sneak up on you! Don't tell me you've never done that! I saw you!

The KJV uses the word "circumspectly" in Ephesians 5:15 to describe the Christian's walk, or how we are to live. That word means "to look in a circle." Think about that a minute. Take away all the paranoia of walking through the graveyard at night and see what walking this way accomplishes. It means that you are totally aware of what's happening around you. Your eyes are wide open to see. Nothing is going to sneak up on you and take you by surprise.

That's the way we as Christians are to live. We are not ignorant of Satan's schemes. We know how he operates and we make every effort to not fall into any of his traps. When sin comes sneakin' up, we can see it coming before it gets too close. So we can avoid it.

I like God's word-pictures, don't you? After all, a picture is worth...."
